To finish this round of training, we would like you to put together presentations about your work to be given on Zoom which demonstrates some of the skills you have practiced during the training.

- You can work individually or in a group with your fellow trainees.
- Your presentation can be in English or Arabic.
- Your presentation should be 10 minutes long.
- Discuss and agree with your Training Manager (TM) the topic, your presentation idea and whether you are presenting in a group or individually.
- A date in January will be agreed between you and your TM for all groups/participants in each country to present their mini-projects on zoom.
- Each TM with the participants of each country will choose one of the presented mini-projects to be presented at the Final Event.
- The Final Event and Presentations of all EAMENA-CPF 2020 participants will take place on Wednesday January 13, 2021.

This presentation could be a sum of the activities that you have been doing for this training (if you have been working on the same dataset) to answer your research question(s):

- You could use data from GEE to identify disturbances or to study and illustrate major landscape changes in your area of interest and how these changes are threatening sites.
- You could present the sites on the watchlist you have compiled and work with one or more of your colleagues to compare/study the sites that each of you included on your watchlist in the larger area/landscape.

You could also set a new research question looking at a larger area

- You could work with one or more of your colleagues and use the advanced search in the database to export your combined data in GIS to create a map showing the distribution of sites and/or conduct further geospatial analysis.
