WHY – PURPOSE OF A WATCHLIST


 Helps to understand overall condition of heritage, identify the ones that are most at risk, and in need of safeguarding and protection

 Calls for attention (at national and international level)

PURPOSE OF A WATCHLIST - FOR RESEARCH AND PLANNING

- To understand whether a specific type of heritage/archaeology is under threat and/or is getting destroyed
- To identify threats that have produced or will produce the most destructive damage to the sites (based on monitoring changes over time); Any patterns (location, type, etc.)
- To identify strategies (mitigation and preservation) based on identified problems
- Raise funds and/or prioritize allocation of available resources (human, financial) to implement intervention/mitigation activities

PRIORITIZATION – HOW TO PRIORITIZE



PRIORITY LEVELS

PRIORITY LEVEL	Definition of Priority based on the time period within witch the heritage has to be protected and any Intervention/Protection Activities need to be implemented				
Emergency	Immediate Action				
Urgent	within 6 months to a year				
High	within 1 to 2 years (short-term actions)				
Medium	within 2 to 5 years (mid-term actions)				
Low	beyond 5 years (long-term actions)				

Create a watchlist of the **most threatened significant** sites in the trainees' selected regions / datasets.

Sites to represent different types of archaeology, cultural periods, and regions in each country

Based on

 Representativeness and Importance – of a type or archaeological period in a specific region

- Highest possibility of threat and/or level of severity of condition of sites in need of protection
